85% Merlot

Merlot brings this wine a bright ruby color, smoothness and red fruits aromas.

15% Cabernet Sauvignon

This is a traditional grape variety in the Bordeaux region. It brings the wine structure and ageing potential thanks to its powerful tannins. Cabernet Sauvignon is characterized by an aromatic profile of black fruits such as blackcurrant but also liquorice.

Tasting notes of Roger C. Bohmrich—Master of Wine

Moderately dense garnet with purple. Very appealing, clean and youthful aroma of healthy, mature dark cherry and damson plum with faint spice notes. The wine is round, supple and medium bodied plus on the palate, thoroughly enjoyable now, and imparts a soft final impression with the barest touch of tannin. Modern in the best sense, L'Orangerie is an excellent entry-level red Bordeaux.

Food Pairing

This wine is very food-friendly and will match every day meals (pasta, chicken, home-made burgers) but would also be good with delicatessen food and is ideal for dinner parties.

Ageing

Wine lovers of young wine will be surprised by the complexity and freshness of the tannins. This Bordeaux Superieur reaches its best in 5-6 years.
